

Manual abstract:

) If required, an ALPINE dealer will readily provide you with a print out of the Owner's Manual contained in the CD-ROM. Please record the serial number of your unit in the space provided below and keep it as a permanent record. This symbol means important instructions. Failure to heed them can result in serious injury or death. **DO NOT OPERATE ANY FUNCTION THAT TAKES YOUR ATTENTION AWAY FROM SAFELY DRIVING YOUR VEHICLE.** Any function that requires your prolonged attention should only be performed after coming to a complete stop. Always stop the vehicle in a safe location before performing these functions. Excessive volume levels that obscure sounds such as emergency vehicle sirens or road warning signals (train crossings, etc.) can be dangerous and may result in an accident.
