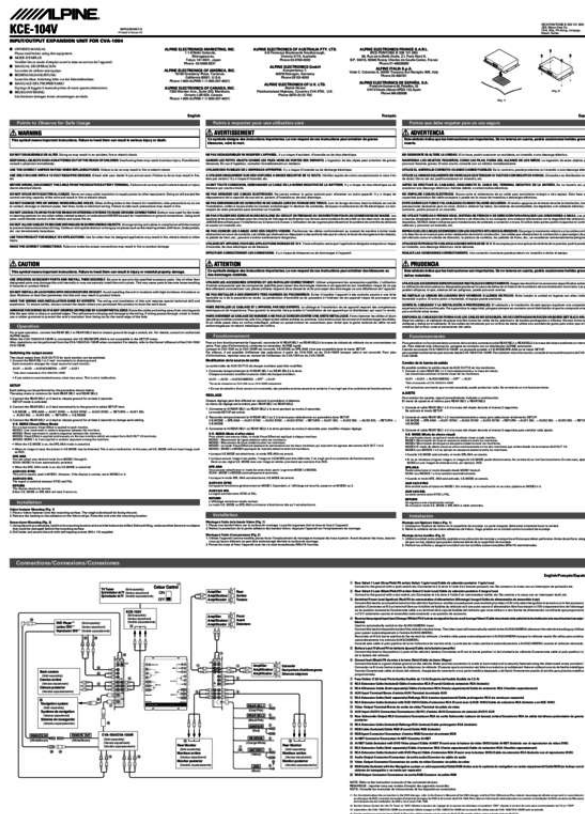

**Manual abstract:**

Failure to heed them can result in serious injury or death. Doing so may result in an accident, fire or electric shock. **KEEP SMALL OBJECTS SUCH AS BATTERIES OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.** Swallowing them may result in serious injury. (Check with your dealer if you are not sure. Never cut away cable insulation to supply power to other equipment. Doing so will exceed the current carrying capacity of the wire and result in fire or electric shock. **DO NOT DAMAGE PIPE OR WIRING WHEN DRILLING HOLES.** When drilling holes in the chassis for installation, take precautions so as not to contact, damage or obstruct pipes, fuel lines, tanks or electrical wiring. Failure to take such precautions may result in fire.

@@@ do NOT ALLOW CABLES TO BECOME ENTANGLED IN SURROUNDING OBJECTS. Arrange wiring and cables in compliance with the manual to prevent obstructions when driving. Cables or wiring that obstruct or hang up on places such as the steering wheel, shift lever, brake pedals, etc.

Use for other than its designed application may result in fire, electric shock or other injury. **MAKE THE CORRECT CONNECTIONS.**

Failure to make the proper connections may result in fire or product damage. Failure to heed them can result in injury or material property damage. **USE SPECIFIED ACCESSORY PARTS AND INSTALL THEM SECURELY.** Be sure to use only the specified accessory parts. Use of other than designated parts may damage this unit internally or may not securely install the unit in place.

This may cause parts to become loose resulting in hazards or product failure. **DO NOT INSTALL IN LOCATIONS WITH HIGH MOISTURE OR DUST.** Avoid installing the unit in locations with high incidence of moisture or dust. Moisture or dust that penetrates into this unit may result in product failure. **HAVE THE WIRING AND INSTALLATION DONE BY EXPERTS.** @@@@ This will prevent crimping and damage to the wiring. @@@@ for details, consult an authorized ALPINE dealer. When the CVA-1004/CVA-1004R is connected, the V. ANA is not accessible in the SETUP menu. @@@@ 1.

Connect the REAR SEL1 or 2 lead momentarily to chassis ground. Each connection changes the visual source for each monitor. @@ This is not a malfunction. **SETUP** Each setting can be performed by the procedure shown below. The setup menu is common for both REAR SEL1 and REAR SEL2. 1. @@@@ MODE4: MODE 1 to 3 are applied in random sequence among the monitors. This is not a malfunction. ANA You can select your desired mode from MODE1 through 6. AUX1/2/3 SYNC This unit is usually used in MODE1.

However, if the display is unclear, set to MODE2 or 3. AUX1/2/3 SIG. The signal is switched between NTSC and PAL. The rough side should be facing the unit. 2.

Remove the backing to the adhesive on the Velcro strips. Press the unit onto the mounting location. Using the unit as a template, hold it at its mounting location and mark the holes to be drilled. Before drilling, make sure that there are no objects that could be damaged behind the mounting surface. 2. Drill holes and secure the unit with self-tapping screws (M4 x 14) supplied.
