If this option does not appear, contact your wireless service provider. · I want to use a work email account with a BlackBerry Enterprise Server: This option is most common for corporate users. If your administrator gave you an enterprise activation password, use this option to associate your device with your work email account using the BlackBerry® Enterprise Server. 3.
