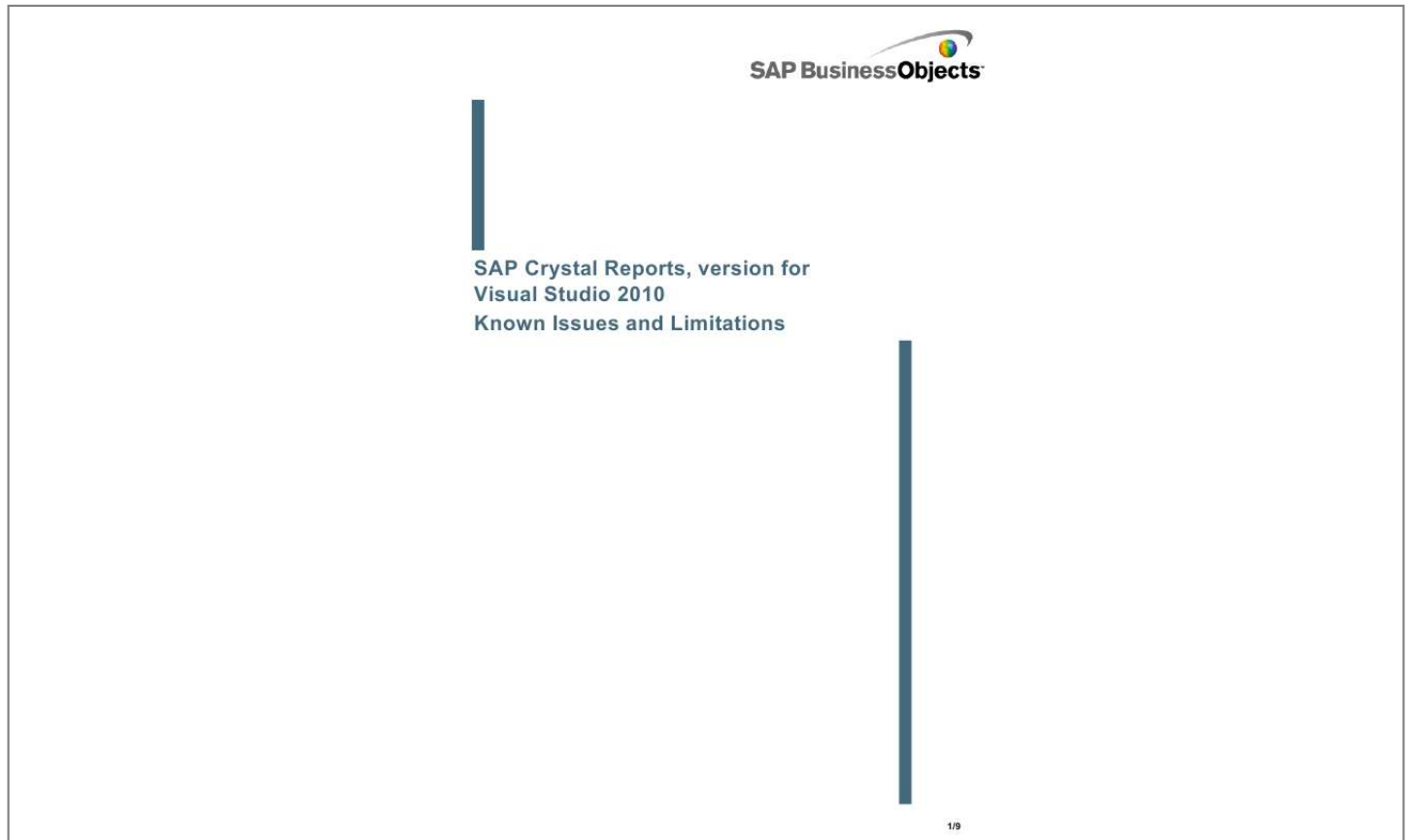

The viewer must be added to the toolbox manually. The parameter panel may be rendered incorrectly if the parameter field prompt text is longer than the width of the parameter panel When a user enters a parameter value, the parameter panel may be rendered incorrectly if the parameter field prompt text is longer than the width of the parameter panel. To resolve this issue, resize the panel to fit the prompt text. The toolbar and group tree disappear if the Crystal Report Viewer is put into an update panel The toolbar and group tree do not appear in Crystal Reports Viewer if it has been put into an update panel. Also, the page does not refresh when clicking any links in the viewer.

@@Ensure all report names do not include special characters such as &,#,@,!,%, etc. The Wtion Reports do not automatically display bi-directional languages correctly When reports are viewed on a computer configured for a bi-directional language (for example, Hebrew), the report will not automatically display text right-to-left unless the report is formatted to display text right-to-left. Usability Manually typing a value in the zoom control box has no effect Manually typing a value in the Zoom Control box while you are viewing a Crystal report at design time has no effect. @@@@It is the report designer's responsibility to clearly indicate that a parameter is optional and can have no value.
