

- 2. Installing the Software**
 - 1 Insert the Canoscan Setup Utility CD-ROM into the drive.
 - Warning:**
 - When you read online help, be sure to read the introduction and frequently asked questions for the software system. Details are provided on the website.
 - For more information on the CD-ROM, see the CD-ROM and the user manual.
 - Prerequisite:** Canoscan LIDE 25 or Canoscan LIDE 60 CD-ROM can be the software.
 - 1 Click **Install** on the main menu.
 - 2 Click **Install** on the "Install" window.
 - 3 Follow the on-screen message prompts to continue the installation.
 - 5 When "Installation completed successfully" appears, click **Finish**.
- 3. Unlatching the Scanning Unit**



Push the lock switch to the unlock (left) position.


- 4. Connecting the Scanner**


Connect the scanner to the computer with the supplied USB interface cable.


- 5. Try Scanning**
 - 1 Place an image to be scanned onto the document glass.
 - 1 **Scan** (Auto) (PhotoStudio).
 - Warning:**
 - Do not touch the scanner glass (PhotoStudio) when the scanner is in use.
 - 3 Click **File** (menu), **Select Source**, and select the scanner as input.
 - 4 Click the scanner icon  or click **File** (menu) and select **Device**. ScanGear CS will start.
 - 5 Select a **Source** option and click **Preview**.
 - 6 Click **Start**. The first scan will start.
 - 7 Click the **Close** icon  (Macintosh) in the ScanGear CS window, and save the scanned image in the PhotoStudio window.

- 7. Setting the Stand (Canoscan LIDE 60 only)**
 - 1 Remove the scanner directly above the stand in a flat place.
 - 2 Adjust the scanner into an upright position until the lock-clicking stops.
