ENGLISH

Read this instruction booklet carefully before installing and using the appliance. In this way, you will obtain the best possible results and maximum operating safety.

Presentation

The Dehumidifier removes humidity from the air in the areas in which it is installed. The appliance is compact and fitted with wheels and handles which facilitate its movement. This appliance is recommended for all rooms in which excessive humidity is liable to build up, e.g. kitchens, bathrooms, laundry rooms, cellars etc. Experts have established the optimal atmospheric conditions, both for our physical health and the preservation of furniture and other items, vary between 45% and 65% relative humidity. It is therefore advisable to keep rooms within these values.

Electrical connection (U.K. only)

If your appliance comes fitted with a plug, it will incorporate a 13 Amp fuse. If it does not fit your socket, the plug should be cut off from the mains lead and an appropriate plug fitted, as below.

WARNING: Very carefully remove the cut-off plug after removing the fuse; do not insert in a 13 Amp socket elsewhere in the house as this could cause a fire hazard.

With alternative plug not incorporating a fuse, the circuit must be protected by a 15 Amp fuse. If the plug is a multi-lead type the fuse cover must be removed when changing the fuse using a 15 Amp AD&A approved fuse to BS 1362. In the event of using the base cover, the plug must NOT be fused with replacement base cover cable obtained from your nearest electrical dealer. The colour of the correct replacement fuse cover is that as marked on the base of the plug.

If your appliance is not fitted with a plug, please follow the instructions provided below.

WARNING - THIS APPLIANCE MUST BE EARTHED

IMPORTANT

The wires in the mains lead are coloured in accordance with the following code:

Green and yellow: Earth
Blue: Neutral
Brown: Live



As the colours of the wires in the mains lead may not correspond to the colour code marked on the terminals in your plug, proceed as follows: The green and yellow wire must be connected to the terminal in the plug marked with the letter E or the earth symbol or coloured green or green and yellow. The blue wire must be connected to the terminal marked with the letter N or coloured black. The brown wire must be connected to the terminal marked with the letter L or coloured red.
