- 3) The following features are not supported on this driver.
 - a) Color restoration
 - b) Dust removal

Note: The Epson Scan Twain driver Help file includes information on these two features but they are not supported on these scanners.

- 4) If you install Epson Scan 1.25A, and any of the following scanners---Perfection 1670/3170/3200---was installed first on your computer, then the Epson Scan driver for these 3 models will encounter two issues: (a) Epson Scan utility will not launch and (b) the Start button no longer functions.

To restore these two functions to the Perfection 1670/3170/3200, you must install a patch (EPSON Scan Updater 1.0A). Please see bulletin PSB.2003.10.001 for more information about this patch.

Installation:

- 1) Launch the Epson Scan Twain driver Installer and follow the on-screen instructions.

Note: The installer will remove the previous version (1.0) of Epson Scan during the installation.

- 2) Connect the scanner to the computer using a USB or Firewire cable (Epson Firewire I/F board required)

To uninstall:

- 1) Disconnect the cable from the scanner.
- 2) Launch EPSON Scan Installer.
- 3) Change "Easy Install" to "Uninstall" on the main User Interface screen.
