Arrival: Sets an alarm to sound when you arrive at your destination. Off Course: Sets an alarm to sound when your boat is farther off course than the specified distance. Units Position Format: Sets the position values to the selected format. Map Datum: Sets the map datum to the selected format. Heading: Sets the heading value to the selected format. Distance, Speed and Elevation: Sets the values to the selected format. Depth: Sets the depth values to the selected format. Navigation Communications Sets the serial data format and transfer mode. Installation Preparation Before permanently installing any part of the device, plan the installation by determining the location of the various components. @@@@ (4 mm), with an appropriate drill bit for the pilot hole. • To attach the base with bolts, use pan-head bolts, either size #8 or a diameter of 5/32 in.
