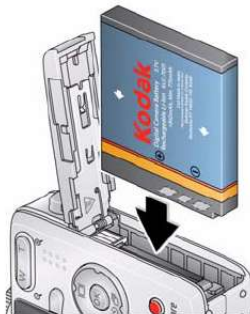

If the mode description turns off before you finish reading it, press OK. 3 Press OK to choose a Scene mode. SCN mode Portrait Flower Sunset Backlight Candle Light For Full-frame portraits of people. To zoom out, press Wide Angle (W). 2 Take the picture. To use the 5X digital zoom: In video mode, press the Telephoto (T) button. In picture-taking mode, press the Telephoto (T) button until the slider on the LCD is at the maximum optical zoom range. Release Telephoto (T), then press it again.
