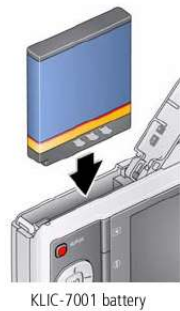

To zoom out, press Wide Angle (W). 3 Take the picture. Using digital zoom Use digital zoom to get up to 5X magnification beyond optical zoom.

(Digital zoom is not available in Smart Capture mode.) Press Telephoto (T) until the slider is at the maximum optical zoom range. Release Telephoto (T), then press it again.
