



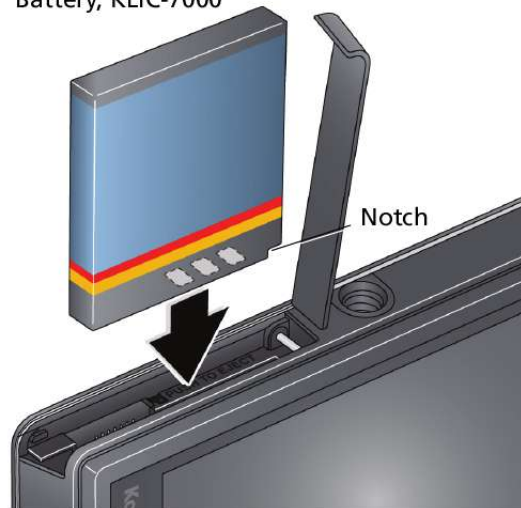

@@@@ Press Telephoto (T) to zoom in. @@@@@ Every time you take a picture. NOTE: Not available in Smart Capture mode. @@A preflash does not fire; the camera corrects red eye. NOTE: Image processing takes longer than when using preflash. Never. @@@@@ You can tag people, locations, or keywords.

@@ Tap the left/right side of the screen (or swipe) to find a picture that contains faces. 2 Tap the Tag icon, tap Tag People, then tap Apply Tags. A Name box is superimposed over each detected face (up to 5). 3 If the camera recognizes a face, confirm it. (If you do nothing, the camera assumes that the names are correct.) If the camera is not correct, tap the Name box, then choose an existing name or add a new one. Repeat these steps to assign names to other faces.

If you delete a picture during a quickview, that picture is not created in the SLICE Album. If you delete a picture from a card or internal memory, that picture is not deleted from the SLICE Album.
