How to use - When the charger is connected, with the power on or off, the Headset will turn off automatically, and cannot be used. While charging, the LED indicator will show a solid blue light. - The buttons will not function while the device is charging. - It takes 2 hours to fully charge the Headset. - When charging is complete, the LED indicator will turn off. - A low battery tone will play once every 30 seconds. - If the battery is not charged, the Headset will turn off. The power will turn on and a booting tone will play.

How to use A shutdown tone will play, the Bluetooth link will disconnect, and the power will turn off. - Prior to using the Headset for the first time, you must pair it with a Bluetooth-enabled handset. - There are 2 Pairing Mode Methods with the HBM-210. How to use How to use With the Power off, press and hold the MFB for 4 seconds, to turn on the HBM-210. The Headset will enter Auto-Reconnect mode, for 10 seconds (If your headset has been previously paired to the handset, the headset will automatically reconnect to the handset, when the HBM-210 is powered on.

) After 10 seconds, the HBM-210 will automatically enter Pairing Mode. When the headset enters Pairing Mode, the LED indicator will show a solid blue light Using your handset, find the Bluetooth Menu and "search for" or "add" new devices. Select "LG HBM-210" from the list of devices and pair it with your handset. @@Once pairing has completed successfully, you will hear a beep. @@@@ 2) Manual Pairing With the Power off, press and hold the MFB for 6 seconds.

When the Headset enters Pairing Mode, the LED indicator will show solid blue light. Using your handset, find the Bluetooth Menu and "search for" or "add" new devices. Select "LG HBM-210" from the list of devices and pair it with your handset. When asked for the Pass/Pin code during the pairing procedure, please enter "0000" (4 Zeros) Once pairing has completed successfully, you will hear a beep. @@@@ Auto Reconnect - When the HBM - 210 turns off (accidentally or intentionally) while connected to a handset, the headset and handset will disconnect. The Headset and handset will automatically reconnect when the HBM- 210 is turned back on(as long as both devices are within the required range of 33ft. or 10m). [ Out of range ] - When the HBM - 210 and your handset are separated by a distance of 33 feet (10 meters) or more, the Headset and handset will disconnect. When the handset and HBM - 210 are brought back within the required distance, the HBM - 210 will automatically reconnect with the handset. - If the Headset and handset do not automatically reconnect when they are back within the required range, briefly press the MFB on the HBM210 to reconnect manually.

Calling Answering a call - When there is an incoming call, the Headset will ring. - Briefly press the MFB to answer an incoming call. Making a call - If you make a call from the handset, the call will (subject to phone settings) automatically transfer to the Headset. If the call is not automatically transferred, you can manually transfer the call by briefly pressing the MFB on the HBM - 210 (handset and headset must be paired). How to use You will get the best results if you record the voice dialing tag through your Headset. NOTE: If the handset does not support Voice Dialing, it is possible that performing this action will activate Last Number redial. @@The headset will beep, and call the last number dialed. ending a call - Briefly press the MFB. @@@@ Press the MFB for 1 second to return to the original call. - Briefly press the MFB to terminate both calls at once.
