Chapter 2: Installing Vocal Studio 5 8 In the Pro Tools MP3 Export Option dialog, deselect the Use my iLok Smart Key option, then click Next. 9 When prompted, enter your Pro Tools MP3 Export Option serial code (authorization code). 10 Click Next and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the authorization process.
