Manual abstract:

By setting the proper control range of the pedal, any player can control their keyboard's or controller's expression parameter to maximize its potential as an effective tool for live sound sculpting. The M-Audio EX-P is a universal expression pedal, meaning it will work with any device with an expression pedal input. However, there are a couple of different standards employed between various manufacturers, so M-Audio has included a mode switch on the bottom of the pedal for compatibility. When in the "M-Audio" position, the EX-P will work with all of M-Audio's keyboards and controllers. When using the EX-P with another company's device, you may need to move this switch to the "Other" position if the pedal is not behaving properly. @@@@ 2. Move the EX-P into the fully forward, or "up," position. Your instrument will now be set to play at full volume. @@@@ 4. @@@@ This equipment generates, uses and can radiate radio frequency energy and, if not installed and used in accordance with the instructions, may cause harmful interference to radio communications.
