

<p><b>1 CHARGE</b> Your Headset's Battery</p>  <p><b>1</b> Plug the Motorola charger into the end of the headset.</p> <p>The indicator light turns on when the battery is charging. It may take up to 30 seconds for the light to turn on. When the headset's battery is fully charged (about 3 hours), the indicator light is steadily lit in blue.</p> <p><b>2</b> Unplug the charger from the headset.</p> <p><i>Note: Headset is not functional while charging.</i></p>	<p><b>2 START BLUETOOTH FEATURE</b> Your Phone</p> <p>Your phone's Bluetooth® feature is off by default. To use your headset, you must turn on the Bluetooth feature in your phone.</p> <p>For most Motorola phones (at the main menu):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>1</b> Press <b>[Menu]</b> &gt; <b>Settings</b> &gt; <b>Connection</b> &gt; <b>Bluetooth Link</b> &gt; <b>Setup</b>.</li><li><b>2</b> Scroll to <b>Power</b>.</li><li><b>3</b> Select <b>Change</b>.</li><li><b>4</b> Scroll to <b>On</b>.</li><li><b>5</b> Press <b>Select</b> to turn on the Bluetooth feature. 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**Manual abstract:**

After a few moments, the indicator light will be steadily lit in blue to indicate headset is in pairing mode. Volume Buttons MAKING CALLS Function Make a voice dial call Action Tap the Call button and speak the name after the tone Tap the Call button Tap the Call button Press and hold either Volume button until incoming call stops ringing Press and hold the Call button for at least 2 seconds until you hear a beep Tap both Volume buttons

CHECKING BATTERY LEVEL To check battery level while headset is powered on, press and hold both volume buttons for 5 seconds until you hear a beep. The indicator light displays the following charge status for a few seconds.
