WEARING THE HEADSET To wear your headset, flex the earhook and loop it over your ear as shown. Your headset's performance is greatly dependent upon achieving a good fit on your ear.

Therefore, we recommend trying all the supplied earbuds with your headset. Be sure to position the ear cushion into your ear canal for optimal audio performance and comfort. CHANGING FOR USE ON OTHER EAR You can wear your H390 headset on your left or right ear. The headset comes ready for the right ear. To change the headset for the left ear: CHANGING VOLUME BUTTON ORIENTATION You can also change the orientation of the volume buttons on your headset.

1 Turn the headset power off. 2 Press and hold the Volume button you want to assign as the "volume up" button and slide the switch toward the microphone. The indicator light flashes blue three times, then steady blue. When connected, it will flash blue/purple. 1 Gently lift and pull the top of the earhook up and off speaker stem, as shown. 2 Flip the headset over. 3 Attach the earhook to the speaker stem, as shown.
