

Supplied Accessories


Make sure you have the following accessories:

*1 Configuration of the rubber stoppers may be different from the figure, such as being 2 sheets instead of 1 sheet, but the total number will be same.




Using the Remote Controller

Before connecting the power cord, connect all of your speakers and AV components.


1. Connecting Your Speakers

When used with onscreen menus, they work as cursor buttons to select and set items.

ENTER is also used with onscreen menus. m Returns to the previous menu. n.Adjusts the volume. o The Music Optimizer function enhances the sound quality of compressed music files.

p Connects a standard pair of stereo headphones. q Adjusts the tone. r Selects the input sources. s Connects a camcorder or similar for audio/video playback. The AV receiver turns off unexpectedly.

g The AV receiver will automatically enter standby mode when Auto Standby is set and launched. There's no sound, or it's very quiet. Make sure that the proper digital source is selected. There's no picture. Make sure that all video connecting plugs are pushed in all the way. h n If you can't resolve the issue yourself, try resetting the AV receiver before contacting your Onkyo dealer. @@.
