8) *procps* is the package that has a bunch of small useful utilities that give information about processes using the */proc* filesystem. The package includes the programs *ps*, *top*, *vmstat*, *w*, *kill*, *free*, *slabtop*, and *skill*. 13) This *PSmisc* package is a set of some small useful utilities that use the *proc* filesystem. We're not about changing the world, but providing the system administrator with some help in common tasks. Instead, it is used to filter text, i. e. , it takes text input, performs some operation (or set of operations) on it, and outputs the modified text. *Sed* is typically used for extracting part of a file using pattern matching or substituting multiple occurrences of a string within a file. 17) *GNU Tar* provides the ability to create tar archives, as well as various other kinds of manipulation. For example, you can use *Tar* on previously created archives to extract files, to store additional files, or to update or list files which were already stored.
