Digital 320 Creative Kit Your Polaroid PhotoMAX FUN! Digital 320 Creative Kit contains everything you need to take digital photographs and save them to your computer. Using the software in your kit you can correct, edit and play with your digital photos. You can use your Polaroid PhotoMAX Image Maker Software with other digital cameras and scanners if they are TWAIN-compliant. Check the instructions that came with your device to see if it is TWAIN-compliant.

2 Kit components Make sure that your kit contains the following: · Polaroid Digital 320 Camera · Serial interface cable · 9-volt battery · Polaroid PhotoMAX SE 2.1 Image Maker Software CD-ROM Note: Your computer needs a RS-232C serial port to use your digital camera. Polaroid PhotoMAX FUN! @@1. Open the battery door as shown. 2.

Insert one 9-volt battery into the compartment. @@3. @@Digital 320 Creative Kit 5 To take a picture 1. Turn on the camera. The green power light on the back of the camera is lit. @@2. Look through the camera viewfinder. Hold the camera steady and press the shutter button. Keep holding the camera steady until you hear a beep. When you hear the beep, a picture has been taken.

6 The picture counter on the back of the camera shows you how many pictures you have stored in your camera. Your camera can store up to 18 images. Note: Your camera automatically shuts off after a few minutes if you don't take a picture. This helps to save your battery power. The camera beeps to let you know that it is in power saving mode. When the camera beeps turn the camera off or take another photo. Press the shutter button to take a photo while the camera is beeping. The camera turns itself on when you press the shutter button and takes the photo normally. Polaroid PhotoMAX FUN! Digital 320 Creative Kit 7 Tips for great photos Follow the steps on this page to take great photos with your Polaroid Digital 320 Camera. Indoor photos 3-6 feet Take photos in a brightly lit room that has a mixture of both sunlight and lamp light.

For best results, take a photo near a large window. 8 Outdoor photos 3 feet to infinity Take photos in sunlight or in bright shade. Avoid intense sunlight that may cause sun spots in photos. Always make sure that the sun or other light source is behind the person taking the photo. Polaroid PhotoMAX FUN! Digital 320 Creative Kit 9 Using the self-timer Your digital camera comes with a built-in self timer. Note: It is recommended that you use a tripod with the self-timer. There is a tripod mount on the bottom of your digital camera. 1.

Look through the viewfinder to compose your photo. 2. Press the self-timer button. 3. The camera makes a beeping noise. The beeping continues for approximately 10 seconds. After 10 seconds the camera makes a long beeping noise as the photo is taken. To do this, you must first install the Polaroid PhotoMAX Image Maker Software included in your kit. Your software includes many fun and interesting features to use with your digital photos: · Polaroid's Image Quality Assured (IQA) one-click fix technology that instantly improves any digital image. · A wide selection of digital special effects such as melting, swirling, motion blur and more. Full preview of all your changes as you make them. @@@@Insert the CD-ROM in your CD-ROM drive. 2. Follow the instructions on your computer screen. 3. If the installation program does not start automatically: a. Select Run from the Windows Start menu.

The Start menu is usually found at the bottom of your screen. b. Click Browse to locate your CD-ROM drive. c. Select Setup.exe from the CD-ROM. d. Click Open. e. Click OK and follow the instructions on your computer screen.

Applying a special effect You can apply many different special effects to a selected part of your photo or to the entire photo. Try making part of your photo look like an oil painting! 1. Select the area on your image that you want to paint, or make sure no area is selected if you want to paint the entire image. 2. Click Special Effects. 3. Click the down arrow on the tool palette until you see the painting special effect.*
