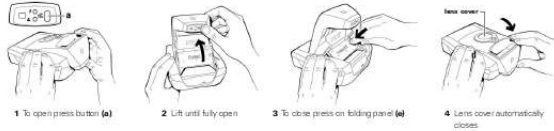

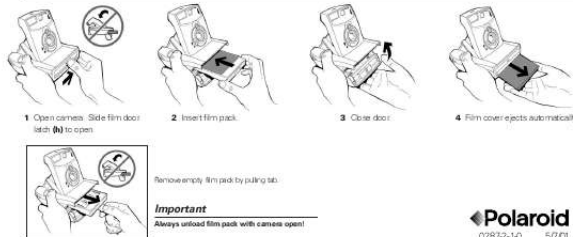

Load Film (Important: Always load film pack with camera open!)

Manual abstract:

Always unload film pack with camera open! Note: If green light (b) is off, lightly touch The red close-up light (d) turns on. Return switch to normal position close-up picture is taken. Blurry Picture Cause Too close Solution If less than 4 ft (1. Spots on Pictures Cause Dirty rollers Subject moves Make sure subject is not moving in low light levels. solution Open camera. Openfilm door and clean rollers with damp cloth. Beyond flash range Stand between 4 - 10 ft. If this camera proves defective within one year of the original purchase date, Polaroid will, at our option, repair or replace any camera found defective in manufacture within the warranty period. the warranty period is determined by the date of camera purchase. Keep the receipt as proof of purchase.

@@@Avoid contacting skin, eyes, or mouth with the paste. @@Do not cut or take apart photos or battery. Do not burn battery or allow metal to touch its terminals. @@@This camera is powered by batteries contained within the film pack. Supervise children when camera is operated by them or used in their presence.

To avoid electrical shock, do not expose to or immerse in water or other fluids, disassemble, or operate if dropped or damaged. @@.
