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Manual abstract:

The camera's unique micro design enables digital video recording in situations where it may not be possible to use standard consumer camcorders. While charging, the Charging Indicator will blink slowly. Once it's fully charged, the Charging Indicator will remain on. If the batteries have an adequate charge and the camera is on, but no button has been pressed for 15 seconds, it will automatically shut off. Insert the micro SD memory card into the Memory Card Slot on the left side of the camera with the electrical contacts facing upward toward the Camera Lens. Push the Power Button to turn on the camera. The Battery Indicator will light for 4 seconds, and then shut off. The Status Indicator will then light, and the camera is ready. If no memory card is inserted, the Battery Indicator will light for 4 seconds and turn off. This will be followed by the Status Indicator flashing.

Press the Power Button and Insert a MicroSD card and follow Steps 1 & 2. To take a still picture, press the Photo Button. The Status Indicator will flash once; the photo is recorded. The photo will be saved as a jpg file. To transfer recorded files to your PC for viewing or saving, connect the camera to the computer using the provided USB Cable connected between the camera and an available USB port on your computer. Your camera will become an external drive and will be assigned a drive letter by the computer. Once recognized by your computer, you can copy and paste files to the folder of your choice and/or delete files. An autoplay menu should pop up on the screen.

Select the Open folder to view files option. In the Search box, type notepad. (Using a 24 hour clock, hour 12 is noon, 13 is 1pm, 14 is 2pm.
