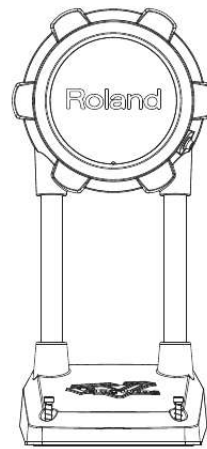

In the case of the symbol at left, it means that the power-cord plug must be unplugged from the outlet. Used for instructions intended to alert the user to the risk of death or severe injury should the unit be used improperly. Refer all servicing to your retailer, the nearest Roland Service Center, or an authorized Roland distributor, as listed on the "Information" page. Never install the unit in any of the following locations. Subject to temperature extremes (e.

g., direct sunlight in an enclosed vehicle, near a heating duct, on top of heat-generating equipment); or are Damp (e.g., baths, washrooms, on wet floors); or are Exposed to steam or smoke; or are Subject to salt exposure; or are Humid; or are Exposed to rain; or are Dusty or sandy; or are Subject to high levels of vibration and shakiness. Never allow foreign objects (e.

g., flammable objects, coins, wires) or liquids (e.g., water or juice) to enter this product. Doing so may cause short circuits, faulty operation, or other malfunctions. CAUTION Try to prevent cords and cables from becoming entangled. Also, all cords and cables should be placed so they are out of the reach of children. Never climb on top of, nor place heavy objects on the unit. Should you remove anchor bolts, springs, bolts, and washers keep them in a safe place out of children's reach, so there is no chance of them being swallowed accidentally. In households with small children, an adult should provide supervision until the child is capable of following all the rules essential for the safe operation of the unit.

2 IMPORTANT NOTES Placement Do not expose the unit to direct sunlight, place it near devices that radiate heat, leave it inside an enclosed vehicle, or otherwise subject it to temperature extremes. Excessive heat can deform or discolor the unit. When moved from one location to another where the temperature and/or humidity is very different, water droplets (condensation) may form inside the unit. Damage or malfunction may result if you attempt to use the unit in this condition. Rough handling can lead to malfunctions. When connecting / disconnecting all cables, grasp the connector itself--never pull on the cable. This way you will avoid causing shorts, or damage to the cable's internal elements. To avoid disturbing your neighbors, try to keep the unit's volume at reasonable levels. You may prefer to use headphones, so you do not need to be concerned about those around you. This instrument is designed to minimize the extraneous sounds produced when it's played.

However, since sound vibrations can be transmitted through floors and walls to a greater degree than expected, take care not to allow these sounds to become a nuisance to neighbors, especially when using headphones. When you need to transport the unit, package it in the box (including padding) that it came in, if possible. Otherwise, you will need to use equivalent packaging materials. That should keep it in place and make it easier for you to play. * When used on flooring, the anchor bolts may damage the floor.

Adjust the anchor bolts correctly. * The tips of the anchor bolts are sharp.
