On the Lucina AX-09, the sounds you can select and play are called "tones.

There are two kinds of tones: "Regular Tones" and "Special Tones." Selecting a Regular Tone 1 Press one of the [1][6] buttons to select a group. Group 1 SYNTH / PAD 2 PIANO / KEYBOARD 3 ORGAN / ACCORDION 4 STRINGS / CHOIR 5 BRASS / WINDS 6 GUITAR / BASS Explanation Synthesizer/pad (sustained synth) sounds Piano and keyboard sounds Organ and accordion sounds String and chorus sounds Brass and woodwind sounds Guitar and bass sounds This chapter explains how to select sounds. What are Regular Tones? Regular tones are organized into six groups, with 24 variations in each group.

The display shows the variation number. Try playing the keyboard. In this case, you could lower the key range by a semitone, and play the song using C-major tuning--in other words, using just the white keys! Raising or Lowering the Key Range by Semitones 1 Hold down the [TRANPOSE] button and use the [+]/[-] buttons to raise/lower the key range in steps of a semitone. You can change the key range by -5+6 semitones. To return to the original key range, hold down the [TRANPOSE] button and the [+]/[-] buttons simultaneously. Touch controller The touch controller lets you vary the pitch by moving your finger.

For example, you can use this to simulate the way in which a guitarist bends the pitch of a string. D Beam You can vary the sound by moving your hand over the D Beam sensor. For example, if you've selected PITCH, the pitch will change when you move your hand over the D Beam while playing the keyboard. 8 For details, refer to p. 12 in the "Owner's Manual." 4 Playing Along with a Favorite Song Connecting a Portable Audio Player and

Playing Along with a Song 1 Connect your portable audio player. Use a stereo mini (1/8") cable (sold separately) to connect your player to the EXT IN jack. You can connect your portable audio player to the Lucina AX-09, and play the Lucina AX-09 along with your favorite songs.

You can also copy audio files (MP3, WAV, AIFF) from your computer to USB memory, and play them through the Lucina AX-09. What files can I play from USB memory? You can play MP3, WAV, or AIFF files. Files of the following formats can be played. MP3 Format Sampling Frequency Bit Rate WAV, AIFF Sampling Frequency Bit Rate 44.1 kHz 8/16/24-bit MPEG-1 audio layer 3 44.1 kHz 32/40/48/56/64/80/96/112/128/160/192/224/256/320 kbps, VBR (Variable Bit Rate) 2 Play back a song on your portable audio player, and play along on the Lucina AX-09. Use the controls of your player to adjust the volume. 10 Copying Audio Files (MP3, WAV, AIFF) to USB Memory for Playback on the Lucina AX-09 The Lucina AX-09 can play back audio files (MP3, WAV, AIFF) from USB memory. Before you proceed, you'll need to copy the audio files from your computer to the root level of your USB memory, and insert the USB memory into the Lucina AX-09. English Copy to USB drive MP3, WAV, AIFF Insert USB memory Deutsch 1 Press the [AUDIO PLAYER] button.

*3 When the button lights up, the Lucina AX-09 is ready to play songs from USB memory. To select a song, hold down the [AUDIO PLAYER] button and use the [INC/+] or [DEC/] button.
