Manual abstract:

The following pictograms are used in these operating instructions / on the device: The textiles used in this device meet the high human ecological safety requirements of the Öko-Text Standard 100 as proven in tests at the TESTEX Research Institute. Do not dry the heating pad or the removable cover in the tumble dryer. do not iron the heating pad or the removable cover. Do not clean with chemicals/dry clean. Keep children away from the device! Risk of loss of life by electric shock from damaged mains lead or mains plug! These instructions in a safe place and always pass on all documents together with the heating pad. Please familiarise yourself with the heating pad before getting started and using it for the first time. Please read the following operating instructions and the important safety instructions carefully. Use the heating pad only as described and for the stated areas of use. This heating pad is designed to warm the human body. It allows you to apply heat to specific areas of the body.

This heating pad is not intended for use in hospitals or for commercial use. In particular it must not be used for babies or infants, persons who are Any use other than that described above or modification of the heating pad are not permissible and may lead to injury and / or damage to the heating pad.

CAUTION! Take care that you do not fall asleep while the heating pad is in operation. Excessively long use can cause skin burns. Do not use the heating pad on any part of the body that is inflamed, injured or swollen. Seek medical advice before using the heating pad if in doubt. such inflammation , injuries and / or swelling may otherwise worsen. Never immerse the control unit 1 in water or other liquids. otherwise you might damage it. Do not hang the heating pad up to dry with pegs or similar. the heating pad may otherwise be damaged. @@@@Clean the textile cover in accordance with the cleaning symbols on the label: The heating pad and removable cover are machine washable.

Do not dry the heating pad or the removable cover in the tumble dryer. do not iron the heating pad or the removable cover. Do not clean with chemicals / dry clean. Take care when replacing the heating pad in the textile cover that the cable exits at the end of the zip. It will not otherwise be possible to close the zip.

For ecological reasons, please only wash the heating pad together with other textiles. Use a mild laundry detergent according to the manufacturer's instructions. please note that frequent washing will cause wear to the heating pad. It should therefore be washed no more than max. 10 times in a washing machine throughout its useful life.

Please note that the heating pad may not be dry cleaned, bleached, wrung out, dried mechanically, mangled or ironed. If you do not intend to use the heating pad for any length of time, store it in the original packaging in a dry environment and without weighing it down. The warranty for this appliance is for 3 years from the date of purchase. The appliance has been manufactured with care and meticulously examined before delivery. Please retain your receipt as proof of purchase. In the event of a warranty claim, please make contact by telephone with our Service Department. Only in this way can a post-free despatch for your goods be assured. The warranty covers only claims for material and manufacturing defects, but not for transport damage, for wearing parts or for damage to fragile components, e. This product is for private use only and is not intended for commercial use. The warranty is void in the case of abusive and improper handling, use of force and internal tampering not carried out by our authorized service branch.
