HCB-100 can also be used as a wireless speakerphone in the home or office.

@@@Press to make and answer calls. @@@ Press and hold to pair the speakerphone with a phone. Press and hold to turn the indicators off and on. @@@ Getting started Introducción First time use Utilización por primera vez Before you use the speakerphone with a phone for the first time, you need to make sure that: · Bluetooth is turned on in your phone. @@@After you have paired the speakerphone with the phone, it automatically connects to the phone as soon as it is turned on and within range.

You select a colour to identify each phone you use with the speakerphone. You can also replace a phone with another phone for a specific colour. a free colour is indicated by the Color ID flashing quickly. A colour already in use is indicated by the Color ID flashing slowly. Note: The speakerphone switches off if you do not pair it with the phone within 10 minutes.

To pair the speakerphone with a phone 1. Press and hold until the Color ID flashes and you hear a long high tone. Prepare your phone according to the phone user guide. When successfully paired, the speakerphone beeps and the selected colour is always lit. @@@@Note: If the phone is out of range for more than 10 minutes, the speakerphone is automatically switched off. @@You can use your speakerphone with up to five phones. When turned on, the speakerphone automatically searches for the last phone used. @@@@To turn the indicators off (and on) Press and hold . @@@@Make a call using the phone or using voice dialling. Then easily redial the number using the speakerphone.

To make a call using the phone Use the phone keypad or phone book. @@After the tone, voice dial as you normally would. @@@When the speakerphone rings, press or press to reject a call. @@Cannot pair the speakerphone with the phone Make sure the speakerphone is charged and within range of the phone. Do not have too many solid objects between the phone and the speakerphone. check or re-apply the Bluetooth settings in the phone. Phone and speakerphone do not connect The speakerphone may be connected to another Bluetooth device. manually select your phone , see page 15.

Your phone may be connected to another Bluetooth device, such as a headset. disconnect the other Bluetooth device. You may have paired another handsfree device with your phone. Some phones can only have one handsfree device in their list of devices at a time. please refer to the phone user guide.

The person you are talking to hears an echo Keep the microphone closer to your mouth. Decrease the surrounding noise, for example, make sure the window is closed and decrease the car stereo volume. @@Note: When you reset your speakerphone to the default settings you lose your paired phones. to reset the speakerphone 1. @@@It may need to be recharged a number of times. @@@@We, Sony Ericsson Mobile Communications AB of Nya
