If so, please see below: The StoreJet 25 default file system is FAT32, which allows it to be recognized on most types of computers, game consoles and media playback devices.

However, the FAT32 file system does not support large files that exceed 4GB in size. If you plan to store large files that are larger than 4GB, you will need to convert the drive to a different file system such as NTFS.
