If the AP is not experiencing difficulties, then there is no need to download a more recent firmware version, unless that version has a new feature that you want to use. Note: When you upgrade the AP's firmware, you may lose its configuration settings, so make sure you write down the AP's settings before you upgrade its firmware. To upgrade the AP's firmware: 1. Download the firmware upgrade file from the internet. 2. Extract the firmware upgrade file. 3.

No LED's light up. Cause: The power is not connected. Resolution: Connect the power adapter to your AP and plug it into the power outlet. Note: Only use the power adapter provided with your AP. Using any other adapter may damage your AP.

LAN Connection Problems I can't access my AP. Cause: The unit is not powered on. There is not a network connection. The computer you are using does not have a compatible IP Address. Resolution: Make sure your AP is powered on.

Make sure that your computer has a compatible IP Address. Be sure that the IP Address used on your computer is set to the same subnet as the AP.

@@@Cause: The IP Addresses of the computers are not set correctly. Network cables are not connected properly. @@And the IP must be in the same subnet as the AP. Make sure that the Link LED is on. If it is not, try a different network cable. @@IP Address is not set correctly. Resolution: Make sure that the Mode, SSID, Channel and encryption settings are set the same on each wireless adapter. Make sure that your computer is within range and free from any strong electrical devices that may cause interference.
