Manual abstract:

Four character balls create interactive sound effects as they are dropped into the bus. @@NOTE: Please cut the thin thread that attaches the ball to the bus. The cut thread can be removed from the bottom of the bus. @@Make sure the unit is turned OFF. 2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit.
