Make sure the unit is turned OFF. 2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw. 3. Install 3 new 'AAA' (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure. Getting Started 3 Demo strip removal: When the product is taken out of the packaging, please remove the demo strip from the unit to activate normal play mode.

BATTERY NOTICE The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.

Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged (if removable). Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision (if removable). Do not mix old and new batteries. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
