



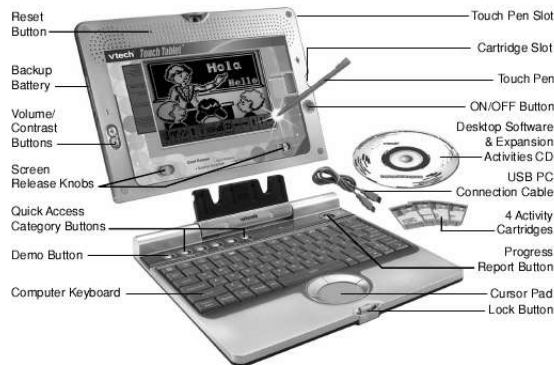

Make sure the unit is turned OFF. 2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the detachable screen and open it. 3. Insert 4 new "AA" batteries (UM-3/LR6) as illustrated.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES ARE NOT RECOMMENDED.

4. Close the battery cover. NOTE: For best performance, remove all factory-installed batteries and use new, alkaline batteries. Important: When replacing the 4 "AA" size batteries, make sure the backup batteries are in the unit. Otherwise you will lose any information stored on the unit.

BACKUP BATTERY INSTALLATION Your Touch Tablet™ comes with a backup battery already installed. To avoid damage to the unit from leaky batteries, replace the backup battery at least once a year. **TO REPLACE THE BACKUP BATTERY** 1. Make sure the unit is OFF. 2.
