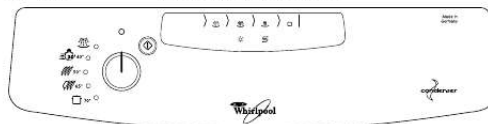

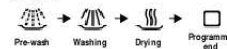


Program selector knob

Automatic start by turning the programme selector knob (in case of retractable knob, first press the knob to access it). Large compartment A: Switch on the appliance How to fill the detergent With each wash cycle. Small compartment B: For programmes with pre-wash only. A B C Check the rinse aid level Mechanical indicator C. Electric indicator on control panel (if provided).

Check the regeneration salt level On models with water softener system only. Mechanical indicator D. Electric indicator on control panel (if provided). Load the racks Close the dishwasher door, turn on the water tap Select a programme Refer to the dishwasher loading instructions. Select the desired programme.
